

Refraction- Is a ***NON-COVERED*** Service by Medicare and most secondary insurance policies.

A Refraction; is a service provided to you from our office and is not a part of your routine visit by an ophthalmologist.

A Refraction is the determination of an eye's refractive error and the best corrective lenses to be prescribed; series of test lenses in graded powers are presented to determine which provide sharpest, clearest vision.

Eyeglass prescriptions are only good for one year. Should you need a new pair of glasses or your vision has changed you will need to have a current prescription. The only way to receive a prescription is by having a Refraction done.

The charge for such refraction in our office is \$25.00, payable by you today. You are not obligated to have this service; however we want you to be completely aware that this is the only way to obtain a written current prescription.

By signing below it does not mean that you will necessarily have this service done but in the event you may need a refraction, we want to make sure you understand your insurance coverage.
