

REFRACTION

Refraction – Is a **NONCOVERED** service by most insurance policies.

The Refraction; is a **MANDATORY** test Dr. Gaddy requires each patient to have at least once a year during your annual exam. This is a valuable test that allows him to properly diagnose, treat and determine any changes that have occurred since the last exam.

A Refraction is the determination of an eyes refractive error and the best corrective lenses to be prescribed; a series of test lenses in graded powers are presented to determine which provide the sharpest, clearest vision.

Eyeglass prescriptions as well as contact lens prescriptions are only good for one year. Should you need a new pair of glasses or your vision has changed you will need to have a current prescription on file. The only way to receive a prescription is by having the Refraction done.

The charge for the Refraction in our office is \$30.00 to be collected at check out after the service is rendered.

CONTACT LENS FEES:

In the event that you desire to be fitted with contact lenses, **there will be an additional fee of \$45.00 to be collected at the same time the Refraction fee is collected.**
